- A durable water bottle, like a Nalgene.

SWIMMING AT THE RESERVOIR

At the discretion of the camp director, campers may be given the opportunity to go swimming at a local reservoir and/or participate in water fights at camp. Campers should bring swimwear that is modest: girls, one piece bathing suits; boys, swimming trunks. Bikinis, skin-tight Speedo trunks, or any swimwear that does not properly cover the body is not allowed. At the discretion of the camp director, campers may be asked to wear a t-shirt over swimwear or not to participate if appropriate swimwear cannot be obtained.

HIKING AT LANDER CAMP

At the discretion of the camp director, campers may be given the opportunity to go hiking in the mountains surrounding the Lander Camp. Campers should bring sturdy hiking boots/shoes, a water bottle, sunscreen, and a hat.

LANDER LUTHERAN CAMP RULES

1. All campers will at all times live out their Christian faith by word and deed. You are baptized children of God; you are new creations!
2. All campers must remain within the boundaries of the campsite.
3. When the bell tolls, you will have 5 minutes to be at the lodge. Help each other in this task.
4. There will be absolutely no cabin raiding (boys raiding girls' cabins, or vice versa). Violation of this rule will automatically result in your expulsion from camp.
5. Respect your staff at all times, as well as one another's property.
6. All campers will shower at least once a day to check for ticks.
7. Absolutely no food will be allowed in the cabins. This is state law.
8. Absolutely no electronic devices of any kind will be allowed (cell phones, radios, CD/tape players, video games, etc.).
9. No one is allowed in the kitchen without permission.
10. All campers will participate in all activities to the best of their abilities.

DIRECTIONS

To Lander From Riverton: Turn right at McDonalds (Main Street). Proceed to 5th Street (Safeway corner) and turn left. Go to Fremont Street which is a dead end of 5th Street. Turn right. Follow Fremont Street to a fork in the road and stay left. This is now Sinks Canyon Road. Go to the end of Sinks Canyon Road—about 8–9 miles—to Bruce's parking lot where the switchbacks begin. Continue up switchbacks. At the top stay on the road (about 3-4 miles) until you see the Fremont County (Lander) Youth Camp sign. Turn right - go about 1/4 mile and you are at the camp entrance. Turn right into the camp.

The switchback road may be under construction resulting in the road being closed on weekdays from 10:00 a.m to 4:00 p.m. It is open all day Saturday and Sunday. Please call 1-307-335-7277 for an update on construction.

To Lander from the west: You will be on Main Street when you get into town, turn right on 5th street (Safeway corner) and follow the above directions to the camp.

Alternate Route: This is from the Louis Lake Road entrance on South Pass (highway 28). Enter at the Louis Lake Road parking lot and follow road approximately 10-12 miles until you come to the Youth Camp sign. Turn left 1/4 mile and entrance to the camp is on your right.
