The Speaker: Rev. Brent Kuhlman



Rev. Brent Kuhlman was born in Kimball, NE and raised in Glenrock, WY, where his parents still live. He graduated from Concordia Seminary in St. Louis in 1990 and earned his STM degree in 1995. He served as the pastor of Faith Lutheran Church in Hebron, NE from 1991-1997, and has served as the pastor of Trinity in Murdock, NE since 1997.

Pr. Kuhlman edited the newly revised edition of Koehler's *A Summary of Christian Doctrine* (CPH) and serves as the co-editor of LOGIA Forum and co-host of the radio program “Table Talk” (KNGN McCook, NE).

He has served as a guest professor at Concordia University in Seward, Concordia Theological Seminary in Fort Wayne, IN and at Lutheran Seminary in Novosibirsk, Siberia. He is especially renown for his teaching on Holy Absolution.

Pastor Kuhlman also serves as the Vice President of Higher Things. He served as a plenary speaker at Higher Things Conferences in 2000 (Laramie, WY) and 2007 (Asheville, NC) and serves as the Catechesis chair for Higher Things Conferences.

In addition to his pastoral work, Kuhlman is a substitute teacher and assistant coach for the Elmwood-Murdock junior high girls' basketball team and serves as a baseball umpire.

Pastor Kuhlman is an avid golfer and a *Seinfeld* junky. He and his wife, Robin, live SW of Omaha with their three children, Allison, Jake, and Carlie.

Worship

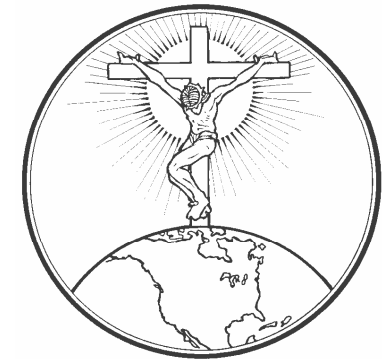
